

SARNIA SWORD CLUB SABRE WORLD CUP

Rules 2014 / 2015 Season

Organiser: Andy Higgs

1. Fencers must wear the kit according to British Fencing required standards; this includes breeches and long socks; otherwise they will not be able to fence in the completion.
2. There will be a round of pools followed by a DE. The DE will be the first to 15 points.
3. Fencers must register their intention to fence in the week's tournament by 19:45, when the check-in will be closed and fencing will start. Failure to register in time will mean you will not be able to fence in that week's competitions.
4. The tournament will be mixed gender, however top three of each gender will receive medals once the final points for the season are determined.
5. Fencers will score points towards the final standings based on their position each tournament as follows.

6. The final results table will be formulated from the results of all events. In case of equality of the final score then a superior higher score will give precedence, and this process will continue down the scores (including if necessary the 2 scores not previously taken into account) until a superior score gives precedence.
